DESIRE IS THE STARTING POINT FOR ALL RICHES

FAILURES ARE PRACTICE SHOTS

- Opportunity has a sly way of appearing through the back door often disguised in the form of a misfortune or defeat.

CREATIVE IMAGINATION

- It's all a matter of perspective and habit. If you have formed a habit of seeing life from your own perspective, you may have made the mistake of believing your limitations are in fact the proper measure of limitations.
- Imagination is a muscle that can be strengthened through use. Creativity in one part of life will bring creativity in another.
- People obtain the status of a genius only when and if they stimulate their mind so they can draw upon the forces available through the creative facility of the imagination.
- Genius: someone who has discovered how to increase the intensity of thought where that person can freely communicate with sources of knowledge not available through the ordinary rate of thought.

AUTO SUGGESTION AND INFINITE INTELLIGENCE

- The subconscious is the link between the finite mind of man and infinite intelligence.
- Auto-suggestion: The repetition of affirmations is like giving orders to your subconscious mind. It is the only known method of the voluntary development of faith: absolute belief that you can do something.
- It is a fact that you will come to believe whatever you repeat to yourself whether the statement is true or not.
- The subconscious mind cannot distinguish between what is real and what is vividly imagined.
- The mind is a creature of habit. It thrives on the dominating thoughts fed to it.
- If you have implanted an idea so strongly that it becomes the dominate idea in your subconscious, it will influence all the other ideas and information stored there.
- Your subconscious will do everything it can to transmute your desire into reality and other people will want to do what they
 can to help you succeed.
